1. MISSION

1.1 Mission

The International Forum for the Aftercare of Horses (IFAR) is a non-profit organisastion dedicated to promoting the care of thoroughbred horses during their lifetime.

1.2 Objectives

2.1 Values

IFAR's mission is founded on the following core values:

- i. **Leadership** the global depth of experience, knowledge and sharing of best practice in securing the lifetime care and alternative careers for thoroughbred racehorses.
- ii. **Accountability** raising awareness of the responsibility by the international racing community and commitment to the welfare of its equine participants.
- iii. **Communication** providing relevant and timely communication between member organisations to facilitate the exchange of information.
- iv. **Empathy** maximising the wellbeing of thoroughbred racehorses and helping develop greater education and understanding by their new owners.
