As Chairman of both the Saudi Equestrian Authority (SEA) and the Jockey Club of Saudi Arabia (JCSA), HRH Prince Bandar plays a key role in the advancement of equestrian sports in Saudi Arabia. With the backing of the Saudi Arabian government, Prince Bandar led a team to successfully deliver the first Saudi Cup in 2020. Under Prince Bandar's Chairmanship and the support of Saudi Arabia's Royal Court, the JCSA will continue development of Saudi Arabia's standing in the world of horse racing, utilising strong ties with the sport's governing bodies to shape The Kingdom's domestic and international racing calendars.

NATASHA ROSE CHAIR, IFAR CONFERENCE COMMITTEE



ROB DAUTH INDUSTRY WIDE RESPONSIBILITY PANEL

Rob Dauth is Director of Growth at MyRacehorse (MRH), having joined in 2021 to co-launch the ownership platform in Australia. A key part of his remit is equine welfare and delivering MRH's commitment to responsible racehorse ownership, where owners play a more active role in welfare and contribute upfront to ensuring all MRH AU horses live long, happy and healthy lives regardless of their deeds on the track. This is primarily achieved through the Horse Super Fund, a fully-funded Group 1 retirement pathway and lifelong safety net that is already responsible for over 50 ex-racehorses enjoying a range of post-racing careers.



DR. ALAN LAI INDUSTRY WIDE RESPONSIBILITY PANEL

Dr. Alan Lai is the Co-Founder of Champs Legacy, the first facility in France dedicated to rehoming, retraining, and paddock retirement for Hong Kong racehorses, currently operating six sites and expanding. He also serves as the CEO of Pet Space Group, Hong Kong's largest veterinary group. In addition to his roles in animal welfare and veterinary care, Dr. Lai is a research scholar at City University of Hong Kong, where he has published several works focusing on pet owners' duty of care. His commitment to improving the lives of animals continues to drive his innovative initiatives.
